

1. Show a model of 4 multiplied by 3.


$4 \times 3 = 12$

2. Show a model of 12 divided by 6.

$12 \div 6 = 2$

3. Solve:

$8 \times 6 = 48$

$10 \div 5 = 2$

$5 \times 2 = 10$

$28 \div 4 = 7$

$9 \times 1 = 9$

$16 \div 2 = 8$


$6 \times 8 = 48$

$48 \div 6 = 8$

4. I have 8 boxes of pencils. Each box has 8 pencils in it. How many pencils do I have altogether?

$64 \div 8 = 8$



5. I have 21 books. Put them into 3 boxes. Each box holds the same number of books. How many books does each box hold?

$42 \div 3 = 21, 21 \times 3 = 42$

= 42 books in 3 boxes
